Buying locally-grown from locally-owned markets promotes a healthy lifestyle, reduces the distance food travels saving fuel, and supports the local economy by keeping dollars in the community. A visit to a roadside market is also an enjoyable experience.

Research also shows consumers will purchase SC grown products through a "sense of pride," preferring homegrown as opposed to that of the competition.

Since not everyone knows which peaches are South Carolina Grown peaches and which barbecue sauce is a South Carolina sauce, the new Certified SC Grown and Certified SC Product logos are a visual introduction for consumers. Using an in-depth media schedule, in-store promotions, public relations initiatives and more, we have launched an actionable, grassroots marketing campaign designed to motivate and activate South Carolina consumers to demand and buy South Carolina grown products. Certified SC is a call-to-action for South Carolina citizens as we ask them to "Buy South Carolina because Nothing's Fresher. Nothing's Finer."

People are rediscovering the health benefits of locally grown and processed products, but buying local is also better for the economy and the environment. It just makes good sense (dollars and cents) to buy local. Buying from our neighboring producers and processors keeps dollars in the community helping to pay for schools, roads, and infrastructure. Buying Certified SC products is also environmentally-friendly. Food and other products travel less distance creating less of an environmental impact from transporting products across country.

The program is about maintaining a stable economy, especially in rural areas of the state. It's about state pride and loyalty - about turning South Carolinians from consumers into advocates.
